sorting objects  
copies patterns/creates own patterns  
recognizes shapes  
rote counting 1-20  
identifies numbers 1-20  
counts objects with 1:1 correspondence

identifies colors  
identifies similarities/differences  
identifies name  
identifies letters  
prints name and other words  
can read environmental print and some sight words  
can retell a story  
can rhyme and clap out syllables
